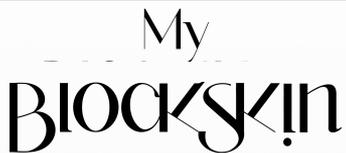

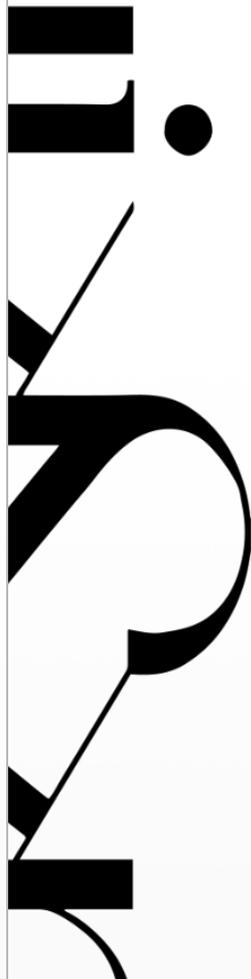

The logo mark serves as the defining visual element of My Block Skin branding, primarily for its use as a textural border element ((left) and also as a framing device in model photography.

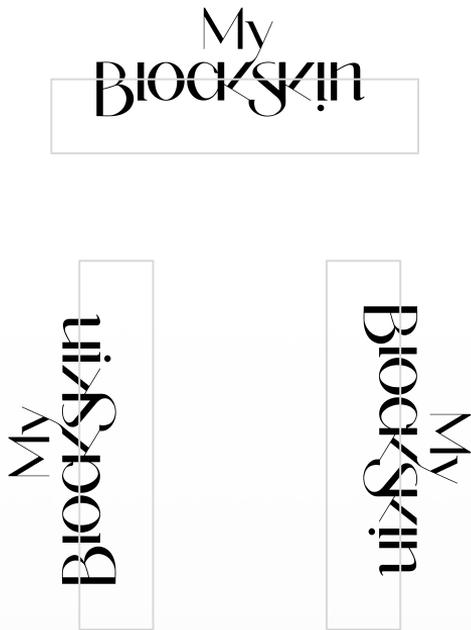
A secondary logo mark may be used for selective OOH instances, where legibility is important (think further away).

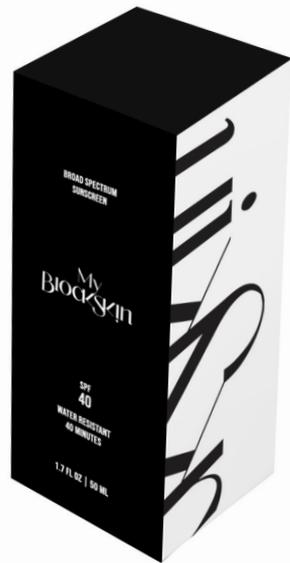

**PACKAGING CONCEPT**

Our brand's essential visual impact lies in our consistent use of a strictly black and white palette.

Gray is employed in limited, necessary cases, such as text containers or highlight. Packaging does not exhibit gray, nor does text/logo ever appear in gray.

*Note balanced white and black use in the developing package design.

COLOR PAIRING/APPLICATION | Apply to text, logo, and design overlays**COLOR BEST PRACTICES**

- Use solid fill
- Avoid gradients
- Avoid drop shadows. The high contrast palette ensures legibility.
- Strive for visual equilibrium between black and white shades used.
- Employ white for text/logo overlay on photographic background

COLOR STROKE

Black, white, or gray

To divide text and use as horizontal or vertical accent

Images can be outlined, but don't have to be

Always use thin weight

1px or comparable in scale

My Block Skin branding has 2 header and subsequent text systems; rather, 2 different combinations.

Subheaders in both systems can appear smaller, no larger (in context of size ratios) than shown.

Uphold size ratios displayed for both font families and do not mix H1's.

To uphold a masculine feel, our second system drops Amerlaryas, the more illustrative fon. Instead, we employ Oswald font as both H1 and H2.

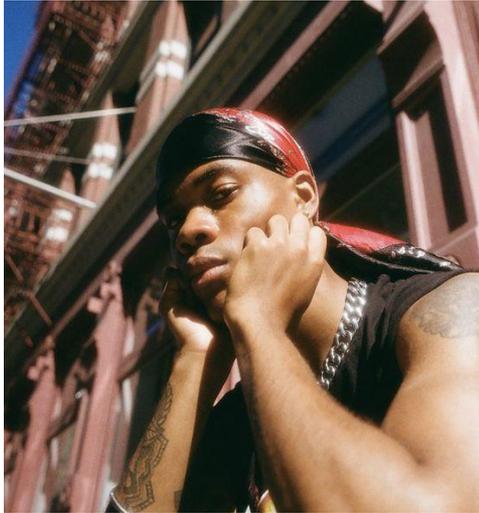

Photography



Subjects should be somewhat up-close, for a focused, "protagonist" feel



Shot outdoors, preferable in golden light. If shot indoors, should have a strong light source with high contrast shadows



There should be an element of spontaneity. Even if posing, it should feel genuine; authentic



Blend industrial and natural settings for visual juxtaposition

**AVOID**

- Black and white photography, as we lean on images to inject color into our visuals
-
- Subjects lit from the back
- Subjects who appear too far away
- Overly-posed subjects
- Extremely saturated imagery, or too cool in tone.

When shooting or selecting photography, stay away from these characteristics.

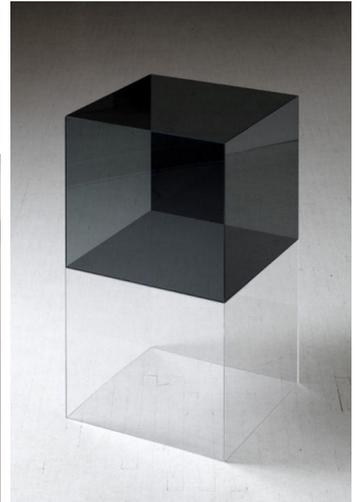

TEXTURE/SURFACES



Mirrored Glass

To reflect the sky and effectively use it as a surface pattern/color pop in the space (playing off of sunscreen).



Clear Acrylic

Enriching the branded space with rich wood textures will help tie in the Soho House Festival vibes and ensure the otherwise clean, posh space also feels warm and relaxing.

Flower Plooms

When we apply our simple brand palette to the space, we can punctuate vivid color into the space via bold flowers. They can be placed in small, localized areas of the space, so the whole space can remain neutral /androgynous in feel.



Simple and Clean

Applying our simple palette to the space ensures a cohesive backdrop for pops of color (like Fud drink product).



Warm Concrete Textures

Deep earth tones, through our mixture of different materials, can create a masculine-leaning, relaxing space.



Color Reflected

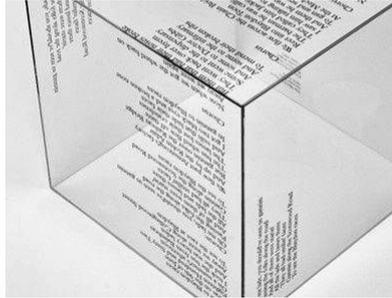
Whether sunny blue skies or cloudy that day - our mirrored surfaces will capture the day's light/tones, making it part of the general color display.
